

PAPER CRAFT

Super Cool Fan

Whew! It's **HOT** in the summer! Make this fan to help you stay **COOL** when you're playing outside. And don't forget to drink plenty of water!

What you'll need:

- 2 paper plates
- Markers
- Craft Stick
- Scissors
- Tissue paper in several colors
- Plastic container for mixing
- White glue
- Water
- Yarn
- Paintbrush
- Newspaper
- Clothes pins

1. Color the front of one plate and the back of another plate with markers.
2. Glue the 2 plates together, and put the craft stick in between to form a handle. Clamp it together with clothes pins or binder clips to dry.
3. Cut flower shapes from tissue paper. Cut a center for each flower and green leaves. Use lots of colors.
4. Mix equal parts glue and water in the container.
5. Paint one side of the fan with the watery glue. Stick some tissue flowers and leaves onto the wet surface. Gently paint more watery glue over the tissue paper. Let it dry. Turn it over and do the same thing on the other side.
6. Cover the handle with glue and wrap it with yarn.
7. When it's dry, use the fan to help you stay cool!
