

FIELD REPORT

PROJECT: Independence Park Main Library

WEATHER CONDITIONS: Partly Cloudy - 56°

OBSERVATIONS:

1) Pile driving is continuing. Approximately 200 piles have been driven.

2) Three concrete pile caps have been completed.

3) Catch basin A-9 is installed and the subsurface drainage system is complete from this point to the existing 72" pipe.

4) The electrical conduits for the electrical loop are installed from BREC's transformer to approximately building column 06:A04.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE:

- 1) Continue the drilling and driving of the piles.
- 2) Continue the installation of the concrete pile caps.
- 3) Continue the installation of the subsurface drainage system.
- 4) The work in the rear parking lot will be completed Monday, February 13th.
- 5) Contractor will setup a preconstruction concrete finish meeting a minimum of one month prior to the first pour of the architectural white concrete.
