

## What You Need:

Cardstock/Construction Paper Crayons/Markers Scissors Straw School Glue/Tape Construction Paper

## Instructions

**Step 1:** Print out the template on cardstock or trace from paper onto construction paper

**Step 2:** Color the unicorn face and extra pieces with markers or crayons

Step 3: Cut out template, extra pieces, and holes for eyes

Step 4: Glue extra pieces on the front of the mask

**Step 5:** Tape/glue straw onto left or right side of mask on the back

**Step 6:** Become a beautiful unicorn anytime you wear the mask!

**Tip:** Recycling can be so much fun! Use your straws for good and make a mask for you and your friends!
