

EXTRA CRAFTY

Christmas in July Gnome

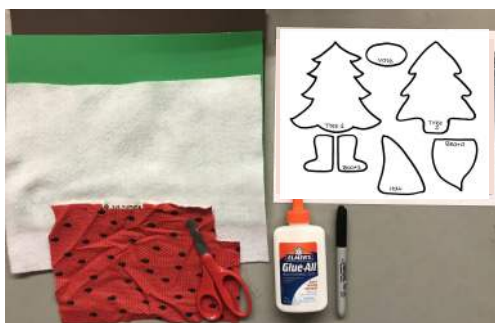


Explore the sense of touch with this festive craft!



You will need the following materials:

1 sheet each of brown and green foam; a piece of white felt; a piece of fabric in the pattern of your choice; scissors; washable school glue; a black marker; printed template



Step 1: Print out the provided template.

Step 2: Cut out template pieces; set the nose aside, you will need that later.

Step 3: Using the black marker, trace the tree piece onto the green foam (the marker may smudge but that's okay).
Cut out the tree.



Step 4: Use the black marker to trace the boots onto the brown foam.
Cut out the boots.

Step 5: Trace the beard onto the white felt and cut it out.



Step 6: Flip your fabric over so the nice side is facing down. Trace the hat onto the fabric and cut it out.



Now we are ready to assemble the gnome!



Step 10: Put a small dot of glue on the top of each boot and secure them to the back of the tree so they look like the tree's trunk.



Step 11: Glue the beard onto the tree at about the halfway point (yarn can also be used for the beard if you want to experiment).



Step 12: Glue the hat onto the tree at the first line of branches. Make sure to put glue at the tip of the tree as well to hold the hat down.



Step 13: Glue the nose over the gap between the hat and the beard.

Your gnomes is complete!
