
Shooting Star Wand



When the weather is nice and the sky is clear, stars fill the night sky. Every once in a while, you might even see a shooting star (meteor) or a comet with a blazing tail streak through the night! While catching a shooting star is unlikely (most meteors burn up in the atmosphere), you can still make this shooting star wand!

SUPPLIES:

- Construction paper
- Tape or glue
- Crayons or markers
- Crepe paper streamers, ribbons, or thin strips of paper
- Scissors

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Roll one paper tightly and tape or glue together to make the stick for your wand
- Cut out two stars using the template on the next page. Decorate with crayons or markers if you wish.
- Glue one star to the top of the wand.
- Glue the ends of the streamers to that star on the same side as your stick is glued.
- Glue the other star on top of the streamers (make a star sandwich –star, stick, streamer ends, star)
- Let dry. Then enjoy!
