
SLOW IT DOWN

Rain Drop Drip Art



SUPPLIES:

-paint thinned with water -straw -paper -cups

On drizzly days, the rain just drips. Drip drip drip!

Too wet to go out, but not really raining, drizzly days can be frustrating!

On a drizzly day (or a nice one) you can take some time to try some drip art! Mix up a few cups with watered down paint, grab some straws, and lay down lots of paper to paint on! You won't need a paintbrush for drip painting!

Put a straw in each color of paint. Place a finger over the end of the straw you would like to use first and gently raise it out of the paint, keeping your finger carefully covering the whole end of the straw. When your straw is over the paint, lift your finger and watch the paint drip down! Practice a few times until you are comfortable holding the paint in the straw, then begin decorating your paper!

Have fun, but don't rush or you might lose your paint!
