Sunset Salt Painting



If you watch as the sun begins to set on a partly cloudy day, you will see the clouds shift from plain white to a rainbow of sunset colors. Watch until the sun is long gone from the sky and they will fade from sunset colors to dark purple and navy.



You can try this out with some fun salt painting!

SUPPLIES:

- water colors (food coloring and water)
- table salt
- glue
- paintbrush
- paper

Directions:

- **Draw a shape or picture on your paper with glue (or trace the attached sunset template with glue)**
- **Shake table salt over the glue. Continue until all the glue is covered.**
- **Wet paintbrush and dip in paint of your choice.**
- **Gently dab paintbrush against the salt and watch the sunset colors spread!**
