

SELF-EXPRESSION:

Charades



A classic clue game to play with two or more people is charades!

You will need some small scraps of paper, something to write with, a timer, and space for the person who is giving the clue to move around.

First everyone writes the name of a thing on a piece of paper (you can make more than one name per person if you want a longer game). Then you mix up the names.

One person picks a word from the name pile, reads it, then hides it in a pocket or sits it where the other person can't see it. Then that person has to try to get the other person to guess that word by giving clues with their actions. The person giving the clues can't say anything!

If the person guesses correctly before the timer rings, they get a point.

The person or team with the most points wins!
