You will need crayons or chalk, paper, and a collection of shoes from around your house for this project.

Mud captures great footprints, but mud is messy and many parents dislike when their kids get muddy.

To capture footprints the easy way, take a shoe and turn it upside down. Place a blank piece of paper over the bottom. Then rub the side of the crayon or chalk across entire paper. A shoeprint will appear!
