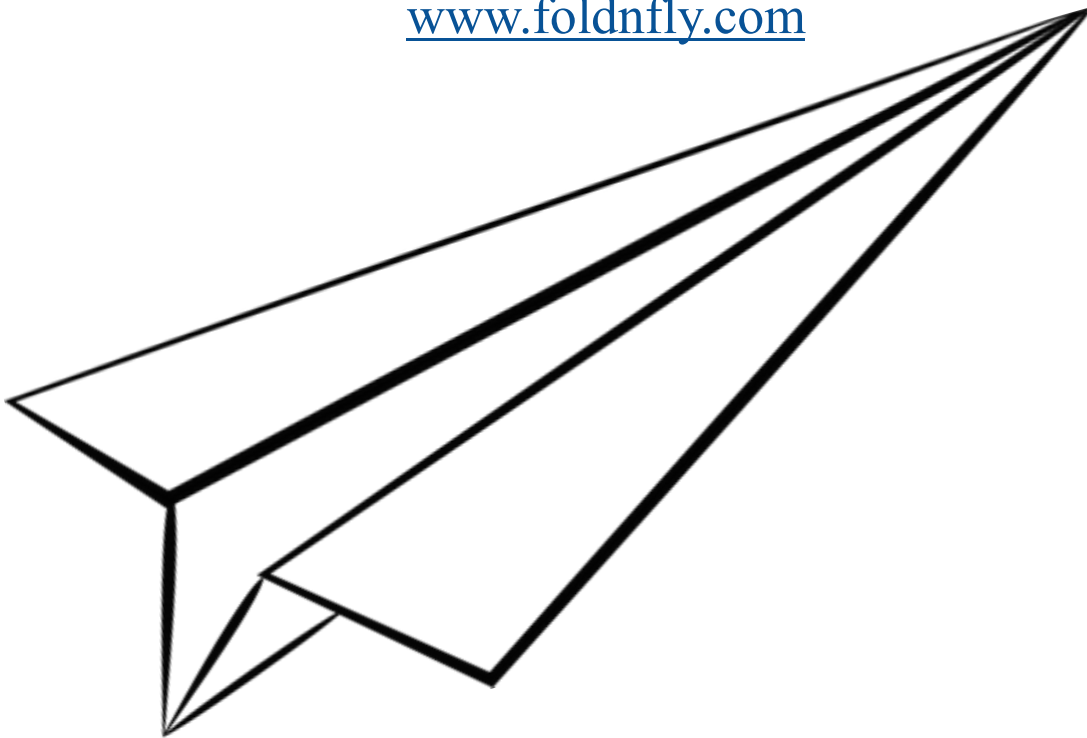


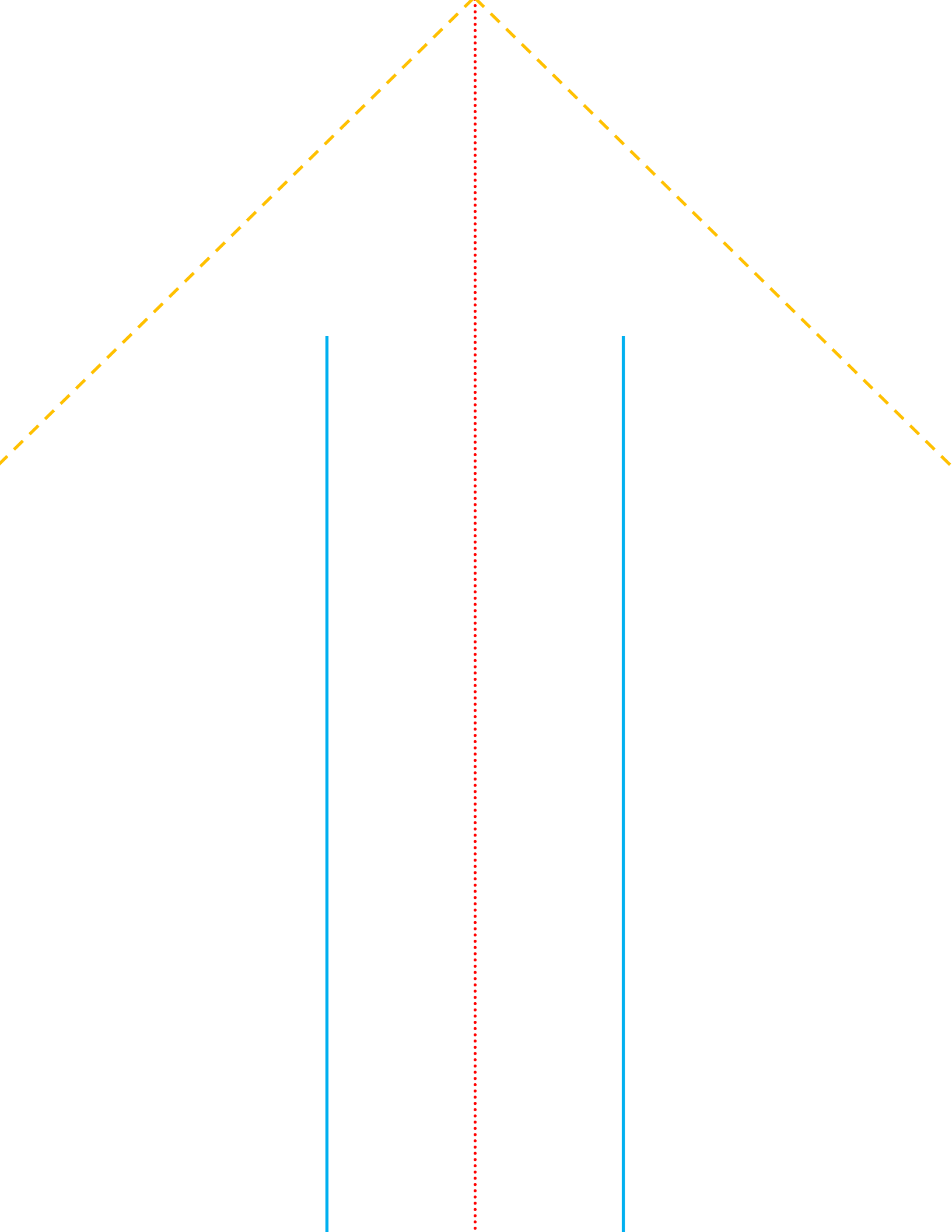
ENGINEERING CHALLENGE Travel The World In A Plane

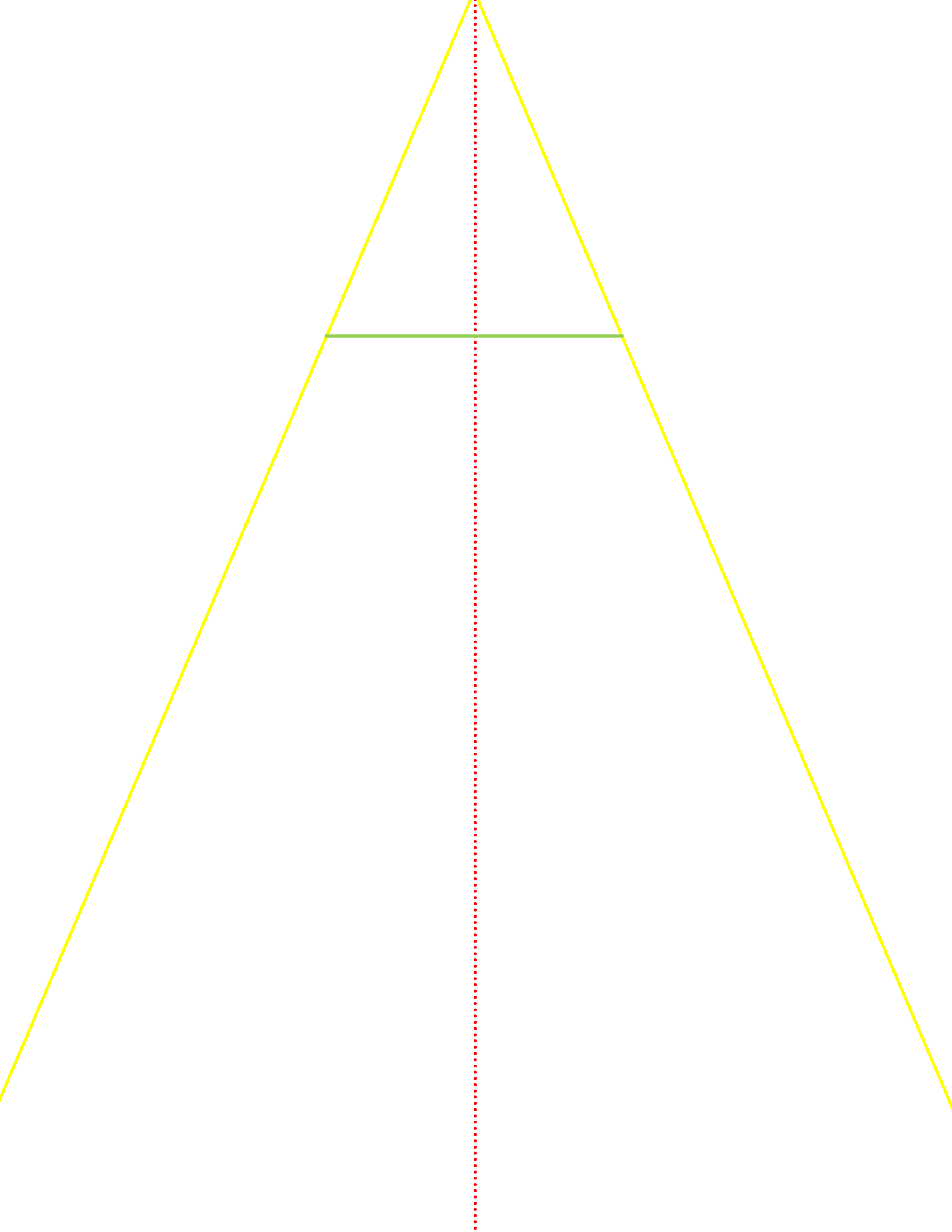
To get across the ocean, you need either a boat or a plane. While a life size plane would be inconvenient to keep in your room, you can make thousands of styles of paper planes!

1. Fold and unfold on the red line.

2. Fold on the orange lines so the edges of the paper line up with the center red line.

3. FLIP PAPER OVER

4. Fold on the yellow line so the edges of the paper line up with the center red line.

5. Fold on the green line so that the point of the plane lines up with the edge of the folded wings.

6. Fold plane closed on the red line. You should see the side of the paper with the blue line.

7. Fold wings down on blue lines.

8. Hold by center spine and launch
