### Personalized Handprint Snowman Storycraft

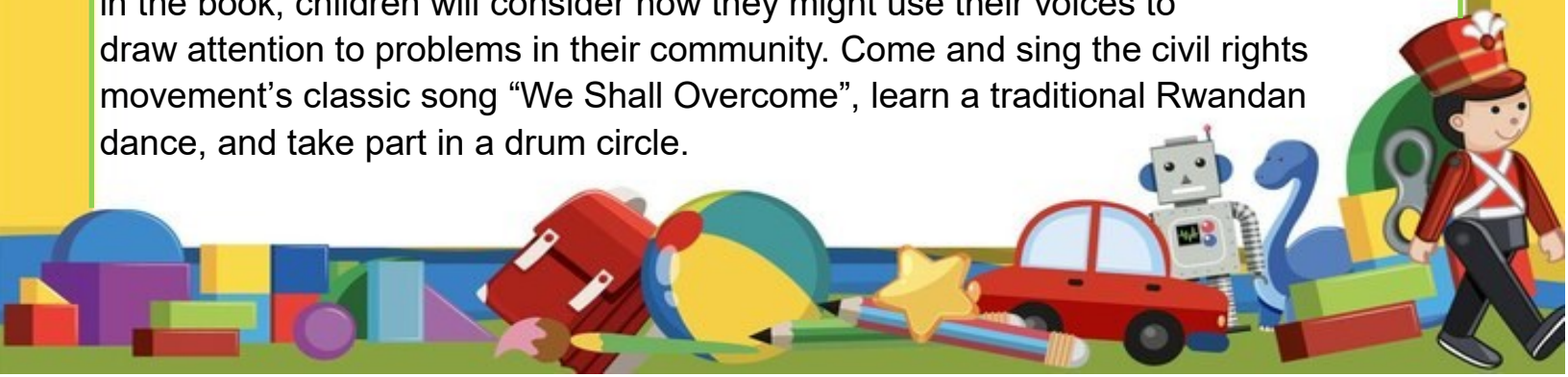
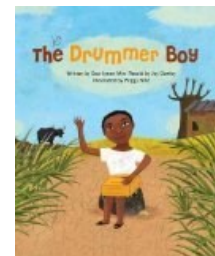

### Books and Music with the Kids Orchestra

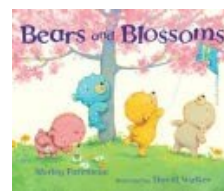
