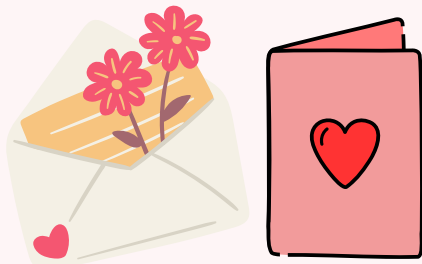


Valentine's Day Card
