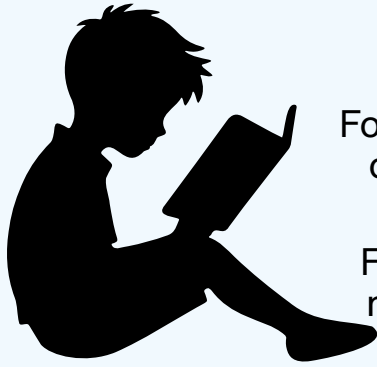
I'm Going to Build a SNOWMAN

For our sensory sensitive patrons, any unnecessary light or sound elements will be turned off in the Children's Room from 11 AM to 1 PM.

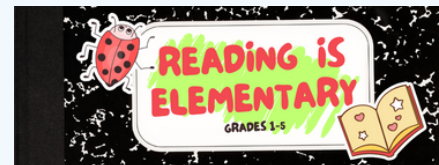
From the Children's service desk, patrons can pick up noise blocking headphones, sunglasses, and various fidget items to use while in the library.
